



## Wallet Binding Tutorial

The instructions in this document will provide you with all the steps required to bind your metamask wallet in advance of the commencement of the GNYi rewards system.

GNYi is GNY.io's multifaceted rewards system that factors in various positive actions taken by GNY token holders and provides the holders bonuses for continually acting in a positive community focused manner. GNYi's rewards system will be powered by GNY's own machine learning predictive technology - and as this is a continuously "learning" process, more details will emerge as this matures.

Please note:

Unless users are currently in the process of becoming a delegate, we **do NOT advise** full migration to the GNY Mainnet Tokens at this time.

**You only have to proceed to the completion of the wallet binding steps shown in this document and then stop. You do not need to click the "Approve" & "Deposit" buttons in the GNY wallet and go through their steps to be eligible for GNYi rewards.**

## Wallet Binding Instructions

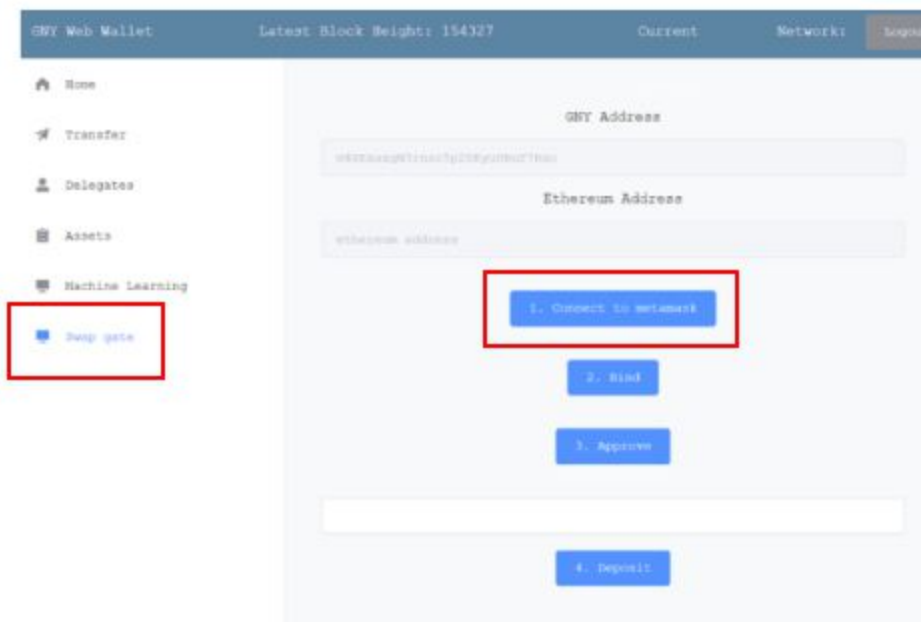
1. Login to <https://wallet.gny.io>

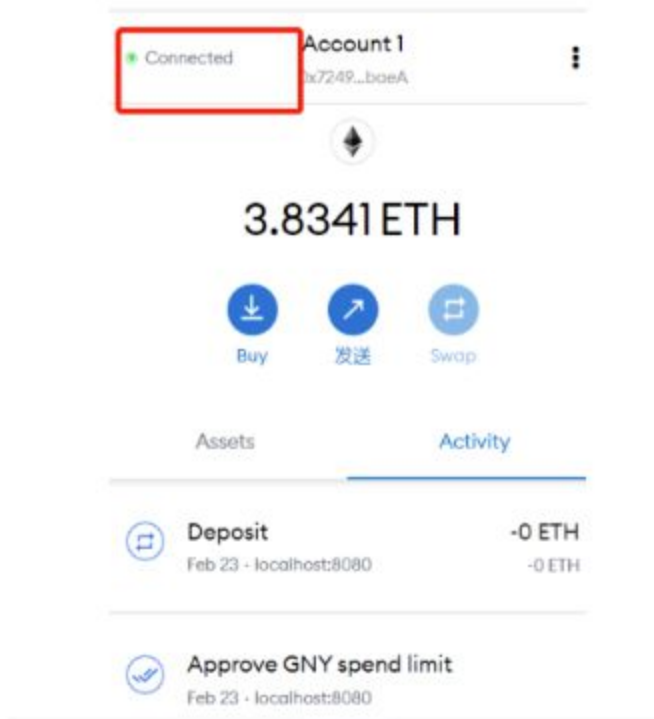

2. Click on Swapgate in the left-hand menu, which will then show 4 clickable buttons on the right side of the wallet.

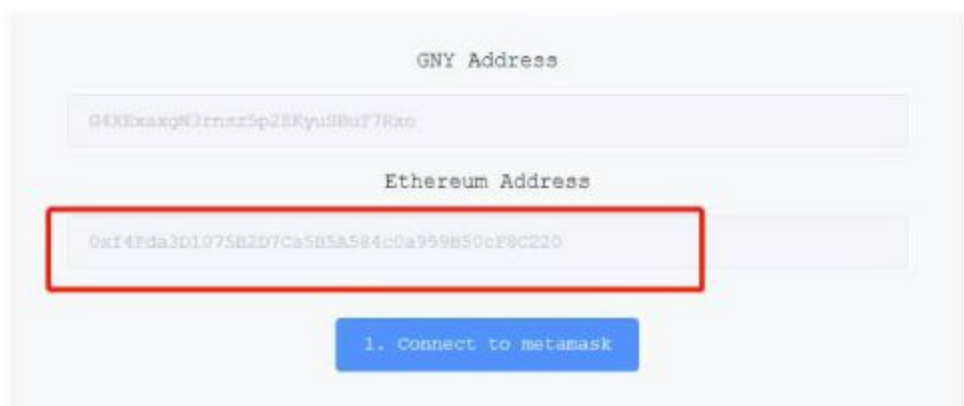
The "Connect to metamask" button is what we will begin with.



3. Click the first button "Connect to metamask" and verify it is connected by looking for the "connected" green light icon shown below.



After the wallet is connected, you will see your Ethereum address populate in your web wallet as shown below.



4. Now you can take the final step by clicking the second GNY Wallet Swapgate button labeled "Bind"
